The CSA Eco Group, a sub group of the CSA aims to support Collis School in developing and implementing specific environmental policies and action plans.

In practice our activities include:

- Helping to make the children more environmentally aware
- Helping the purchase and installation of solar panels on the new building
- Providing gardening areas for use by each year and helping the class activities. Some of the fruit and vegetables are then used in the school kitchen and served to the children as part of their hot lunches.
- Development and maintenance of the nature trail - a mini ecosystem with pond, green house, and outdoor plants for the children and local community to visit and connect with nature.
- Help CSA fundraising activities e.g. by growing and selling plants at school fairs and by having eco related information stands and activities.
- Supporting school eco activities organised by the Eco-Schools Action Team and Green Team and development of the school Green Travel Plan
- Participation in community events such as “Teddington in Flower” and the Schools Environment Forum

We actively seek enthusiastic eco volunteers and gardeners either to help with pupil activity or with specific environmental and gardening initiatives.
