CURRICULUM INFORMATION FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS

YEAR GROUP 1

SUMMER TERM 10

LITERACY Children will be continuing to use their phonic knowledge and blending of sounds to read and write new words and will be using joined writing more consistently. They will be developing their vocabulary and creative writing through role play and drama. They will be looking at a range of texts including fiction, non-fiction and poetry. They will also be developing their understanding and knowledge of basic punctuation.

NUMERACY In number work the children will consolidate their knowledge of addition and subtraction, counting in 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s and using the number line and hundred square. They will be applying these skills to real life situations. The children will also be developing an understanding of money and measures through practical activities. They will be investigating the properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

SCIENCE This term the children will be looking at plant growth and sound and hearing.

HISTORY The children will be learning about what seaside holidays were like in the past.

GEOGRAPHY The children will follow Barnaby Bear to Kenya.

DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY The children will be designing, making, tasting and evaluating their own fruit salad. We will also be designing and making a Malindi t-shirt.

PE The children will be continuing to practise their ball skills and team games. The children will be swimming after half term.

MUSIC The children will recognise the different ways sounds are made and changed and will learn a variety of songs linked to our topics and assemblies.

ART AND CRAFT The children will be looking at the work of a range of artists and learning how to replicate techniques.

INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY The children will be continuing to develop their keyboard and mouse skills and learning how to access a variety of computer programs.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION The children will be learning about Judaism and places of worship.

PERSONAL, SOCIAL, HEALTH AND EMOTIONAL EDUCATION The children will be learning about change, relationships, feelings and emotions. We will also be talking about water safety.
