ENGLISH Punctuation – capitals and full stops, question marks, exclamation marks, commas and speech marks. Spelling patterns linked to appropriate letter formation. Comprehension. Research skills. Writing stories and 'real life' reports. Poetry – nonsense rhymes and riddles.
